ENTRIES

- All entries on the prescribed form or a copy thereof must be accompanied with the stipulated fee. In the event of non-attendance or withdrawal, fees will not be refunded.
- 2. Entry fees:

3. The closing date of entries is 30th March 2017. Entries received after 30th March and before 15th April will be subject to the payment of double the relevant fee per entry.

NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 15th April 2017

4. The age limit for all entries will be as 30th March 2017

APPOINTMENTS

1. Participants will be informed of the date, time and venue of their session shortly after the closing date of entries. This information will be on an appointment slip and allow them entry into the venue for their session

PERFORMANCES

1. It is of vital importance that participants be present at least 20 minutes before the time stated on the card. If a participant wishes to withdraw from a section, the Secretary / Convenor should be notified as soon as possible.

2. Participants will be required to submit for the use of the Adjudicator, a copy of the work to be performed. If this is a photo copy, it will be regarded as non-returnable and will be destroyed immediately after the performance.

NO PARTICIPANT MAY PLAY FROM PHOTO COPIED MUSIC DOING SO COULD CAUSE DISQUALIFICATION

Original music to be available for the adjudicator

- Time limits are not to be exceeded. The adjudicator has the right to terminate a performance which has exceeded the specified time by 30 seconds.
- 4. "*Repeats*" in short pieces are optional, but in longer pieces, e.g. Sonatas, they should be avoided. *Da Capos* should be played.
- 5. Items presented for the **Solo** sections **MAY NOT** be repeated in **any other** section.
- 6. All participants will receive a **report**.
 - a) If a satisfactory performance is attained such participant will receive a Certificate of Honours, Merit or Proficiency.
 - b) Outstanding participants will be awarded a Diploma.
 - In the case of Ensembles / Choirs / Orchestras, only one certificate or diploma will be awarded in the name of the Ensemble / Choir / Orchestra. Individual certificates or diplomas will not be presented to each member.
- 7. Participants who receive **diplomas** will be invited to perform at a *Gala Concert* which will be held at the conclusion of the Festival.

THE ADJUDICATORS' DECISION IN THIS MATTER WILL BE REGARDED AS FINAL

8. Participants must provide their own accompanist who will be admitted free of charge to the venue at which such accompanist is to play.

- 9. In *Vocal items* (Choirs and Soloists), please supply the Adjudicator with a translation where necessary.
- 10. In order to make the **Quick Study** more meaningful, the following rules will apply in all sections and all instruments.

The music chosen for each participant will be two grades lower than that stated on the entry form

- 10, 12 & 14 yrs and under will be given the music 24 hours before the allotted time.
- 16, 18 yrs & under and Open will be given the music two hours before the allotted time.

Participants will be expected to prepare the work without help

AUDIENCE & PUBLIC

- 1. **Season tickets** (inclusive of the program) will be available at R100-00 at the door. This allows attendance at all sessions.
- 2. Season tickets will be available at the door.

ADJUDICATORS

The Festival Committee will appoint competent adjudicators for each category.

Participants, who for religious reasons are not able to play on certain days, should indicate this on the entry form
